

## Post-doctoral Research Associate Positions available in the Department of Entomology at the University of Kentucky

Post-doctoral research associates are needed to participate in NIH, USDA, and private industry-funded research projects in Palli laboratory in the Department of Entomology at the University of Kentucky. These positions are available immediately with funding for one year and a possibility of extension based on the progress and availability of funds. Financial support includes \$47,400 health and life insurance and other benefits.

The applicant would work with faculty of the College of Agriculture, Food and Environment in an interdisciplinary research group focused on improving RNAi in major insect pests and employing CRISPR/Cas9 mediated genome editing to learn functions of critical proteins involved insect development, reproduction, xenobiotic response and epigenetic regulation of hormone action.
